



## **The City of Hialeah Announces the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program**

Made possible with funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City of Hialeah will be opening the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program in 2020 to undertake intervention measures to eliminate the presence of lead-based paint hazards in homes to reduce childhood exposure to lead and prevent lead poisoning to vulnerable populations.

If you are interested in applying for assistance, please see the following preliminary eligibility requirements for the program:

1. Must be a Hialeah resident
2. Must be living in a home that was constructed prior to 1978
3. Must be the owner of the home
4. Must be at or below 80% of the HUD Area Median Income level\*
