

RESOLUTION NO.: 2019-021

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$16,500.00) FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *STATE*, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) CANINE FOR THE HIALEAH POLICE DEPARTMENT CANINE UNIT FROM METRO-DADE K-9 SERVICES, LOWEST QUOTED VENDOR, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department Canine Unit needs to replace one (1) police K-9 dog as there is one (1) retiring as it is too old to be used effectively in the field; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department deploys specialized police canines for the apprehension of subjects, illegal drug detection, and the locating of concealed contraband and explosive devices; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department wishes to purchase one (1) canine from Metro-Dade K-9 Services, the lowest quote vendor; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *State*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the provisions of Section 932.7055 of the Florida Statutes (2017); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed sixteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$16,500.00) from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *State*, to purchase one (1)

canine from Metro-Dade K-9 Services, lowest quoted vendor, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.

**Section 2:** This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




