

## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for City of Hialeah's Police Sub-Station #5 communications and network repair due to damages in Hurricane Irma (DR-4337-FL PW 5592). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 6, 2017 for Hurricane Irma. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

- Floodplain:** Project is located in the AE Zone, otherwise known as the area of 1% annual chance of flooding, per Miami-Dade County FIRM Panels #12086C0114L dated 9/11/2009.
- Proposed Work and Purpose:** The City of Hialeah proposes to use FEMA Public Assistance Funds for having replaced communications and network equipment due to Hurricane Irma.
- Project Alternatives:** The alternative that has been considered is the no action alternative. The no action alternative is not practicable, as the police substation is a critical facility and requires communications and network equipment to operate. Alternative locations were not considered as the limited scope of work did not warrant relocation. Flood hazard minimization has been achieved through installing equipment above the base flood elevation of 8 feet above sea level (2-feet above ground level).
