RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI, AS THE SPONSORING AGENCY OF THE UASI GRANT PROGRAM 2018, UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY'S PREPARING COMMUNITIES FOR COMPLEX COORDINATED TERRORIST ATTACKS (CCTA) GRANT PROGRAM 2016 AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH, AS PARTICIPATING AGENCY; ACCEPTING THE AWARD OF A SUB-GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,900.00 PURSUANT TO SAID MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT APPROVED PLANNING AND EQUIPMENT COSTS IDENTIFIED IN THE PROGRAM BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO, AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1", AND ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) is providing financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$723,260.00 through the Preparing Communities for Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attacks (CCTA) Grant Program 2016;

WHEREAS, the CCTA program reflects the intent of Congress and the Administration to enhance and quantify the preparedness of the nation to combat terrorism and continues to address the unique planning, training, and exercise needs of large high threat urban areas; and

WHEREAS, the funding provides assistance to improve the City of Hialeah's and the region's ability to prepare for, prevent, and respond to complex coordinated terrorist attacks in collaboration with the whole community;

WHEREAS, the City of Miami, as the Sponsoring Agency, is the coordinating agent for the Preparing Communities for Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attacks (CCTA) Grant Program 2016;

WHEREAS, the Sponsorship Agency wishes to work with the participating agencies through to enhance the urban Miami area and its surrounding jurisdictions ability to respond to a terrorist threat or act; and


WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah, as the Participating Agency, find that it is in the best interest of the community to enter into the Memorandum Agreement with the City of Miami to improve and enhance the City of Hialeah's capacity to prepare for, prevent, and respond to complex coordinated terrorist attacks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami, as the sponsoring agency of the Preparing Communities for Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attacks (CCTA) Grant Program 2016, under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the City of Hialeah, as participating agency, accept the award of a sub-grant in the amount of \$9,900.00 pursuant to said Memorandum of Agreement for approved funding to improve the City of Hialeah's and the region's ability to prepare for, prevent, and respond to complex coordinated terrorist attacks, and authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City of Hialeah, to execute the Memorandum of Agreement attached hereto, and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1", and any other documents in furtherance hereof.

PASSED and ADOPTED this 23 day of April, 2019.




