

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-097

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, REPEALING AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2019-034 (MARCH 26, 2019), THAT AUTHORIZED THE USE OF STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$256,557.44 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SEMINOLA ELDERLY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT CONTAINING 83 UNITS OF ELDERLY-OCCUPIED AFFORDABLE HOUSING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-034 (March 26, 2019), City Council authorized the use of State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) program funds in the amount of \$256,557.44 for the construction of the Seminola Elderly Housing Development containing 83 units of elderly-occupied affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to repeal and rescind Resolution No. 2019-034 (March 26, 2019), as the City has found alternative source of funding for the Seminola Elderly Housing Development, and wishes to release the dedicated funds from the State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) Program to be utilized to fund other projects.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby repeals and rescinds Resolution 2019-034 (March 26, 2019), that authorized the use of State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) Program funds in the amount of \$256,557.44 for the construction of the Seminola Elderly Housing Development containing 83 units of elderly-occupied affordable housing.

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


