RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$124,098.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *FEDERAL* ACCOUNT TO PURCHASE THREE (3) 2020 CHEVROLET TAHOE 4WD VEHICLES FROM AUTO NATION CHEVROLET, UTILIZING THE PRICING ESTABLISHED BY A COMPETITIVE BID FROM THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, BID #18-VEL26.0, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department desires to purchase three (3) 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD vehicles at \$41,366.00 per unit, totaling an amount not to exceed \$124,098.00, from Auto Nation Chevrolet, utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association, BID #18-VEL26.0, to replace the aging fleet of vehicles that are no longer cost-effective to maintain; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to replace police vehicles due to age and repair and maintenance expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, these vehicles will allow the Hialeah Police Department to continue to provide service to the patrol and investigative units within the department as well as provide police protection to the residents of the City of Hialeah and Miami-Dade County;

**WHEREAS**, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *Federal*; and


**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the *Guide to Equitable Sharing*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$124,098.00.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *Federal* for the purchase of three (3) 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD vehicles from Auto Nation Chevrolet, utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from Florida Sheriff’s Association, BID #18-VEL26.0, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.

**Section 2:** This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor’s signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor’s veto.




