

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-105

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GEN RECRUITING SOLUTIONS, LLC TO PROVIDE RECRUITING SERVICES, IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMITY WITH THE AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-816 of the City of Hialeah Code of Ordinances, when impractical or not advantageous to the City, competitive bidding may be waived;

WHEREAS, GEN RECRUITING SOLUTIONS, LLC will provide recruiting services to the City, including searching and headhunting, shortlisting and reference checks;

WHEREAS, the City finds it is advantageous to the City and in the best interest, health and welfare of the community to enter into this Professional Services Agreement with GEN RECRUITING SOLUTIONS, LLC. to provide recruiting services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.






