

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-114**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AMENDING HIALEAH FLORIDA RESOLUTION No. 2019-013(FEBRUARY 12, 2019) THAT AUTHORIZED THE APPLICATION FOR, AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (e-RATE) FOR SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES, WHICH INCLUDED A 90% DISCOUNT ON INTERNET SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF HIALEAH PUBLIC LIBRARIES, AND AUTHORIZED THE EXPENDITURE OF \$6,420.00 FOR INTERNET SERVICES, TO REDUCE THE DISCOUNT RATE FROM 90% TO 80%, AND INCREASE THE EXPENDITURE FROM \$6,420.00 TO \$12,840.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Hialeah Florida Resolution No. 2019-013 (February 12, 2019) that authorized the application for, and the acceptance of a grant from the Federal Universal Service Fund (E-rate) for schools and libraries, which included a 90% discount on internet services for the City of Hialeah Public Libraries, and authorized the expenditure of \$6,420.00 for internet services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah, through the Hialeah Public Libraries, has successfully participated in this program for 21 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby amends Hialeah Florida Resolution No. 2019-013 (February 12, 2019) that authorized the application for, and the acceptance of a grant from the Federal Universal Service Fund (E-rate) for schools and libraries, which included a 90% discount on internet services for the City of Hialeah Public Libraries, and authorized the expenditure

of \$6,420.00 for internet services, to reduce the discount rate from 90% to 80%, and increase the expenditure from \$6,420.00 to \$12,840.00.






