RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE LETTER OF AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT TO BEGIN UPON EXECUTION BY THE LAST PARTY TO SIGN ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT "1" BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH AS FUNDED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THROUGH A GRANT CONCERNING PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT; PAYABLE TO THE CITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000 AND ENDING ON MAY 15, 2020, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE EXHIBIT "1" AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENT(S) IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF, AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah finds it in its best interest to accept a grant payable to the city not to exceed \$40,000 through a grant by the University of North Florida and FDOT to support law enforcement in the education and enforcement of pedestrian and bicycle safety, and to help reduce traffic crashes and injuries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The City of Hialeah authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute exhibit "1" and all necessary document(s), and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City.






