

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-137

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$16,714.50 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND- STATE TO PAY FOR THE COUNTY COURT STANDBY PROGRAM SPONSORED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2019; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department, as part of the Miami-Dade County Association of Police Chiefs, participates in the County Court Standby Program to reduce overtime in the Miami-Dade County Courts; and

WHEREAS, the program funds civilian clerical positions to coordinate witness appearances in court through subpoena management reducing police overtime and improving case scheduling in the Courts system; and

WHEREAS, the program has saved police man-hours and overtime as well as aid in the prosecution of cases for the Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - State; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this Resolution and has determined that the proposed expenditure complies with all applicable statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this ordinance are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the expenditure of funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – State in an amount not to exceed

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\$16,714.50 to pay for the City of Hialeah Police Department's share of funding to the County Court Standby Program sponsored by the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police.


