1. The Hialeah Canvassing Board convenes at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections located at 2700 NW 87th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33172. The Canvassing Board is convening for the November 5, 2019 City of Hialeah Primary and Special Elections.

3. Activity
 - Pre-count Logic and Accuracy Test of the optical scan voting system used for vote-by-mail and provisional ballots
 - Approval to commence vote-by-mail ballot opening, processing, and duplication
 - Envelopes of vote-by-mail ballots were sliced open by machinery beginning at 10:07 a.m. by staff of the Miami-Dade County Elections Department.
 - Staff of the Miami-Dade County Elections Department finished opening ballots at 12:12 p.m.
 - Vote-by-mail ballot opening and processing
 - A total of 3,973 vote-by-mail ballots were opened by the staff of the Miami-Dade County Elections Department.
 - A Zero Report was obtained by the Canvassing Board prior to the 3,973 vote-by-mail ballots processed through machine number 8518090377 and 8518090378.
 - Duplication of ballots
 - Staff of the Miami-Dade Elections Department duplicated three (3) ballots which were not read by the ballot processing machine due to being torn.
 - Tabulation was completed 12:45 p.m.

➤ Report with run date of 11/18/19 at 9:09 a.m. shows a total of 3,972 ballots were casted. This is one less ballot because there was an empty envelope with no ballot inside.
