1. The Hialeah Canvassing Board convenes at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections located at 2700 NW 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Miami, Florida 33172. The Canvassing Board is convening for the November 8, 2019 City of Hialeah Primary and Special Elections.

3. Activity
  - Canvassing of vote-by-mail and provisional ballots (as needed)
    - Soft rejects by Canvassing Board on November 5, 2019 were made hard rejects
    - No Signature Affidavit (No identification provided) = 5 ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board, none of which were accepted as legal
    - Signature Does Not Match Affidavit (No identification provided) = 5 ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board, 2 of which were accepted as legal
    - Signature Does Not Match Affidavit (Illegible identification provided) = 3 ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board, 3 of which were accepted as legal
    - Signature Does Not Match Affidavit (Expired identification provided) = 1 ballot was presented to the Canvassing Board, which was accepted as legal
    - Final Totals After Canvassing Review:
      - a. Accepted as Legal = 6
      - b. Rejected as Illegal = 8
      - c. A total of 31 ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board, of which 31 were accepted as legal.
