

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-040**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING AN ADDITIONAL GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA'S TWENTY-FIRST (21<sup>ST</sup>) CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$130,829.00, TO CONTINUE TO FUND THE YOUNG LEADERS WITH CHARACTER STEAM AHEAD AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER PROGRAMS, OPERATING OUT OF THREE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS SITES WITHIN THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FOR STUDENTS FROM GRADES 6 THROUGH 8; RATIFYING THE GRANT AGREEMENT; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS, DOCUMENTS AND SUBCONTRACTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah applied for a grant with the Florida Department of Education for a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant to fund the Young Leaders with Character Steam Ahead Afterschool and Summer Programs operating out of three 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers sites, for students from grades 6 through 8 attending Filer Middle School, Hialeah Middle School and Palm Springs Middle School; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Education awarded the grant to the City of Hialeah, in the amount of \$695,250.00 for the first year, which the City accepted pursuant to Hialeah, Florida Resolution No. 2015-18 (February 10, 2015); and

**WHEREAS**, the grant award was part of a five-year grant cycle commencing in 2015 and ending in 2019, in which the Department of Education funded the first year entirely, and on a five percent (5%) declining award amount each subsequent year for years two through five; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah has been awarded additional funding from the Florida's Twenty-First (21<sup>st</sup>) Century Community Learning Centers Grant in the amount of \$130,829.00 to continue to fund the Young Leaders with Character Steam Ahead Afterschool and Summer Programs operating out of three 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers sites within the City of Hialeah; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community to accept the additional grant award to benefit students by offering quality afterschool and summer programs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts an additional grant award from the Florida's Twenty-First (21<sup>st</sup>) Century Community Learning Centers Grant in the amount of \$130,829.00, to continue to fund the Young Leaders with Character Steam Ahead Afterschool and Summer Programs operating out of three 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers sites within the City of Hialeah, ratifies the Grant Agreement, and further authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute any and all agreements, documents and subcontracts in furtherance thereof.

**Section 3:** This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.
