

**RESOLUTION 2020-033**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, REAPPOINTING **KATRINA M. REY** TO THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH FOR A (3)-YEAR TERM ENDING ON JANUARY 28, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 46-36 of the Code of the City of Hialeah, there is created a historic preservation board as a governmental agency of the city government. The board is vested with the power, authority and jurisdiction to designate, regulate and administer historical, cultural, archaeological and architectural resources in the city, as prescribed by this chapter, under the direct jurisdiction and legislative control of the City Council.

**WHEREAS**, the board shall consist of five members nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.


**WHEREAS**, each member of the board shall hold office only so long as the member is a resident and registered voter of the city.

**WHEREAS**, the term of office shall be for three years for each member.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** Katrina M. Rey is hereby reappointed to the Historic Preservation Board of the City of Hialeah, Florida, for a three (3)-year term ending on January 28, 2023.


