

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-071

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPOINTING COUNCIL MEMBER MONICA PEREZ AS ADULT ADVISOR TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Hialeah, Fla. Charter § 2-614 provides that an adult advisor is to be appointed by majority vote of the City Council to the youth advisory board; and

WHEREAS, Hialeah, Fla. Charter § 2-614 provides that the adult advisor serves as the liaison between young people and the community at large and its elected officials to the youth advisory board, and assists the board in the preparation of requests for monies, including monitoring the spending of monies appropriated by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the youth advisory board only has advisory powers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council retains the sovereign power of the City of Hialeah to make final determinations and decisions upon the recommendations of the youth advisory board such that Councilmember Perez's appointment is consistent with the prohibition against dual office holding; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: Council Member Monica Perez is hereby appointed as adult advisor to the youth advisory board.


Section 3: Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.
