RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE FLORIDA'S TWENTY-FIRST (21ST) CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS GRANT TO FUND THE YOUNG LEADERS WITH CHARACTER STEAM AHEAD AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER PROGRAMS, OPERATING OUT OF THREE 21ST CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS SITES WITHIN THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FOR STUDENTS FROM GRADES 6 THROUGH 8, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$236,695.00, AS FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020, FOR A PERIOD COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1ST, 2020 AND ENDING ON JULY 31ST, 2020; APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HEREAFTER AND INCORPORATED HEREIN AS EXHIBIT "A"; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS, DOCUMENTS AND SUBCONTRACTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah applied for a grant with the Florida Department of Education for a 21st Century Grant to fund the Young Leaders with Character Steam Ahead Afterschool and Summer Programs operating out of three 21st Century Community Learning Centers sites, for students from grades 6 through 8;

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Education awarded the grant to the City of Hialeah, in the amount of \$236,695.00;

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community to accept and approve the grant award to benefit students by offering quality afterschool and summer programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts and approves the grant of the Florida's Twenty-First (21st) Century Community Learning Centers Grant to fund the Young Leaders with Character Steam Ahead Afterschool and Summer Programs, operating out of three 21st

Century Community Learning Centers sites within the City of Hialeah, for students from grades 6 through 8, in the amount of \$236,695.00, as funding for fiscal year 2019-2020, for a period commencing on January 1st, 2020 and ending on July 31st, 2020.

Section 3: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves and ratifies the Grant Agreement between the City of Hialeah and the Florida Department of Education, a copy of which is attached hereafter and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and further authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute any and all agreements, documents and subcontracts in furtherance thereof. All action taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance of the acceptance of the grant award and performance of this agreement is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.




