

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-001

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA URGING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY TO CO-DESIGNATE A PORTION OF EAST 4TH AVENUE, FROM EAST 25 STREET TO EAST 32 STREET, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "JOHN J. BRUNETTI, SR. AVENUE" AS A DISTINGUISHED BUSINESS LEADER IN OUR COMMUNITY AND FOR HIS LIFETIME COMMITMENT TO THE CONTINUED ENHANCEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF THE LANDMARK HIALEAH PARK IN RECOGNITION OF THE PARK'S PROMINENCE IN THE CITY OF HIALEAH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the co-designation of that portion of East 4th Avenue, from East 21 Street to East 32 Street, Hialeah, Florida, as "JOHN J. BRUNETTI SR. AVENUE", presently unnamed, is in recognition of John J. Brunetti's distinguished business leadership in our community and for his dedication to the enhancement and preservation of the landmark Hialeah Park; and

WHEREAS, John J. Brunetti, Sr.'s business acumen and foresight has brought him great prominence in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, since first acquiring Hialeah Park, John J. Brunetti, Sr. has always sought to enhance and preserve the park's beauty, grandeur and charm with which he fell in love; and

WHEREAS, his planned impactful redevelopment of Hialeah Park is anticipated to spur positive change in our community; and

WHEREAS, the City's Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of the co-designation of the portion of the avenue as indicated in this resolution at a special meeting; and

WHEREAS, East 4th Avenue is a county road from West 25 Street north to West 32 Street within the territorial limits of the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, Hialeah Park's eastern boundary abuts the portion of East 4th Avenue sought to be named in honor of John J. Brunetti, Sr. and the Park can be accessed through its winding, scenic and well-known grand entrance from East 4th Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Board of County Commissioners is hereby urged to co-designate the portion of the county road now known as East 4th Avenue, from East 25 Street to East 32 Street, Hialeah, Florida, presently unnamed, as "JOHN J. BRUNETTI, SR. AVENUE".

Section 3: Effective Date.

This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida and signed by the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




