RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, URGING THE SCHOOL BOARD AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO EXPEDITE AND INSTALL SCHOOL ZONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS, BEACONS, SIGNS, AND LIGHTING, TO ADDRESS THE EXCESSIVE SPEED OF MOTORISTS TRAVELING ABOUT THE WEST LAKES PREPARATORY ACADEMY IN HIALEAH DURING SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the School Board of Miami Dade County is offering a pre-K through 6th grade education for school children at West Lakes Preparatory Academy located at 13835 N.W. 97th Avenue, Hialeah, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the School Board's application is pending at the Miami-Dade County's Department of Transportation and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the safety and security of the school children is of paramount importance; and

WHEREAS, local elected officials are in the best position to determine how best to exercise governmental powers to advance priorities for the health and welfare of their community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this ordinance are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City Council hereby strongly respectfully urges the Board of County Commissioners, and the School Board to advance and expedite the pending application for school zone signalization at the West Lakes Preparatory Academy.

Section 3: The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the County Mayor, the Board of County Commissioners, the County Clerk, and to the Superintendent of Schools, the Chair of the Miami-Dade County School Board, the members of the School Board, and to the clerk of the Miami-Dade County Schools.

Section 4: Effective Date.

This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




