

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-013**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OPPOSING SENATE BILL AND HOUSE BILL 1304 AND 1033 RESPECTIVELY AUTHORIZING EXPRESS PREEMPTION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY TO REGULATE DOCKLESS BICYCLES.

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill and House Bill 1304 and 1033 respectively authorizes the express preemption of local government regarding dockless bicycle sharing; and

**WHEREAS**, dockless bicycle sharing can create clutter and obstacles in the City of Hialeah for which the City is in the best position to ameliorate by local regulation; and

**WHEREAS**, in Dallas the number of dockless bicycles has people hostile as bicycles lay strewn on the streets for weeks or months, seemingly without limit to the numbers see: [www.clickorlando.com/news/dallass-rush-into-bikeshare-turns-controversial](http://www.clickorlando.com/news/dallass-rush-into-bikeshare-turns-controversial); and

**WHEREAS**, the City is in the best position to protect the local public health, safety, and welfare.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The foregoing preamble is hereby incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The City of Hialeah respectively urges the Senate and House of Representatives not to adopt Senate Bill and House Bill 1304 and 1033 respectively, without allowing for local regulation.

**Section 3.** The City Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Florida League of Cities, Miami-Dade League of Cities, Miami-Dade County, the Clerk for the Senate and House of Representatives, and such other authorities as may be appropriate.

**Section 4:** This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




