NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Federal regulations governing the US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, require that a participating jurisdiction provide citizens with reasonable notice and an opportunity to comment regarding the proposed use of funds prior to the obligation of any funds received.

The City of Hialeah is eligible to apply for, and accept, a grant award from the United States Department of Justice Assistance's Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for Fiscal Year 2020 for a total amount of \$36,151.00 for the procurement of an unmanned aerial vehicle and compliance with the FBI's National Incident Based reporting Project, authorized uses of Justice Assistance Grant Funds. In order to comply with the above referenced regulations, the City of Hialeah is hereby advising all concerned citizens of a Public Hearing to be held on Tuesday, October 13, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., Hialeah City Hall, City Council Chamber (Third Floor), Hialeah, FL 33010.
