

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-128

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE "AMELIA DISTRICT" COMPRISED OF THE AREA BOUNDED BY THE GRATIGNY HIGHWAY ON THE NORTH, WEST 74TH STREET ON THE SOUTH, AMELIA EARHART PARK ON THE EAST, AND RED ROAD ON THE WEST AND IDENTIFIED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Amelia District, the vision of the Prestige Companies, is situated within the original footprint of what used to be the Miami Municipal Airport, roughly bounded by State Road 924 the Gratigny Parkway on the north, West 74th Street on the south, Amelia Earhart Park on the east, and Red Road on the West; and

WHEREAS, the area has historical significance in that Amelia Earhart departed from the Miami Municipal Airport in her fateful flight around the world; and

WHEREAS, the goal for developments within the Amelia District is to provide modern, vibrant and affordable living communities for younger segments of our population and at the same time remain sensitive to and evoke the history of aviation; and

WHEREAS, it is important for development in the City to keep pace with market demands and the needs of the community by encouraging the development of affordable diverse housing product types and also preserve historical context; and

WHEREAS, identifying the area as the "Amelia District" would create cohesion and community espousing this vision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The area bounded by State Road 924 the Gratigny Parkway on the north, West 74 Street on the south, Amelia Earhart Park on the east and Red Road on the west is hereby established as the "Amelia District". Businesses and all other manner of industry located in the Amelia District are encouraged to refer to the District by utilizing the phrase "Amelia District" or some other phrase of similar import as part of any point

of sale sign permissible pursuant to the City's Sign Code such that the existence of the District may be recognized.

Section 2: Effective Date.






