

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-024

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR, AND IF AWARDED, THE ACCEPTANCE OF, A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (e-RATE) FOR SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES, FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019, FOR INTERNET SERVICES WHEREBY THE GRANT PROVIDES FOR A 90% DISCOUNT TO THE CITY ON INTERNET SERVICES; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$6,420.00 FOR INTERNET SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in its best interest to continue a program for discounted internet for the Hialeah Public Libraries, including the JFK Memorial Library and the Curtiss, North, Walker, West and Wilde e-Libraries branches, funded in part by the Federal Universal Service Fund for Schools and Libraries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah, through the Hialeah Public Libraries, has successfully participated in this program for 21 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the application for, and if awarded, the acceptance of, a grant from the Federal Universal Service Fund (e-Rate) for schools and libraries, for state fiscal year 2018-2019, for internet services whereby the grant provides for a 90% discount to the City on internet services. All action taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance of the application for the grant is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

Section 3: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the expenditure of \$6,420.00 for internet services.

Section 4: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




