RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE LIBRARY'S ANNUAL PLAN OF SERVICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 FOR SUBMITTAL TO THE STATE LIBRARY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY AS A RECIPIENT OF STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS.


**WHEREAS**, the State Aid to Libraries Program is to assist local governments in maintaining and developing free professional library services and in particular, providing equal access to free public library services to all residents of the service areas of participating governments, coordinating library service throughout the service area and providing consistent level of operation, maintenance and development of library services; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to fulfill the requirements of the State Aid to Library Program and applicable federal grant programs, the Hialeah Public Libraries developed an annual plan.






