RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, TO SUBMIT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (U.S. HUD) THE CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REPORT ("CAPER") FOR PROGRAM YEAR 19-20 AND TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS, CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSURANCES IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PROGRAMS IN THE CITY OF HIALEAH ACTION PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE U.S. HUD REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah is an entitlement jurisdiction receiving an annual allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG program funds through U.S. HUD; and

WHEREAS, these funds help the City address the housing, community and economic development objectives by U.S. HUD, which include, but are not limited to furthering fair housing, development of affordable housing, homeless prevention, infrastructure improvements, residential rehabilitation and other services for seniors, the disables and the community; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with U.S. HUD regulations and requirements, the City must submit the Consolidates Annual Evaluation Performance Report (Caper) to U.S. HUD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble this Resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah authorizes the Mayor or his designee on behalf of the City of Hialeah to submit the City of Hialeah Consolidated Annual Evaluation Performance Report

(CAPER) for Program Year 19-20, including amendments, reprogramming of funds and revisions thereto, to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, and to execute any and all agreements and assurances in furtherance of the programs in the City of Hialeah Action Plan in accordance with U.S. HUD regulations and requirements

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




