

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO A FOR THE LEASE OF (9) POLICE MOTORCYCLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$61,020.00 A YEAR FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY-TWO (72) MONTHS FROM ROSSMEYER DAYTONA MOTORCYCLES, INC., DBA BRUCE ROSSMEYER'S DAYTONA HARLEY DAVIDSON, THE LOWEST QUOTED VENDOR, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESSES, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO EXECUTE THE LEASE AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIAL FORM AS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "A".

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department desires to lease (9) 2018 Harley-Davidson FLHP Road King police motorcycles from Rossmeier Daytona Motorcycles, Inc., DBA Bruce Rossmeier's Daytona Harley Davidson, for the purpose of providing police services to its residents, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Hialeah and its residents to lease the motorcycles from Rossmeier Daytona Motorcycles, Inc., under the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Rossmeier Daytona Motorcycles, Inc., is the lowest quoted vendor for the Harley-Davidson FLHP Road King police motorcycles; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witnesses, on behalf of the City, to execute a lease agreement for nine (9) 2018 Harley-Davidson Road King FLHP police motorcycles, in an amount not to exceed \$61,200.00 per year for a period not to exceed 72 months, from Rossmeier Daytona

Motorcycles, Inc., DBA Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley Davidson, the lowest quoted vendor, in substantial form as attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".


