RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA HONORING JAMES MICHAEL (“MIKE”) MILLER FOR HIS 39 YEAR CAREER AS A FIREFIGHTER FOR THE CITY OF HIALEAH WHO SUCCUMBED TO CANCER WITH A PLAQUE AFFIXED TO THE STATION BUILDING AT HIALEAH FIRE STATION NO. 3.

WHEREAS, James Michael (“Mike”) Miller departed this life on January 14, 2021 after a courageous battle with cancer; and

WHEREAS, Mike is survived by his two children, son James Andrew and daughter Melissa Ann and granddaughters Elizabeth, Paige, Riley and Madeline and fiancé Linda DeFrehn; and

WHEREAS, Mike was an avid fisherman, his favorite spot being the Florida Everglades; and

WHEREAS, Mike was born in Huntington, West Virginia on November 20, 1951 and graduated from Fairland High School in 1969; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, Mike served in the US Navy, where he was honorably discharged; and

WHEREAS, after serving in the US Navy, Mike was hired by City of Hialeah Fire Department on February 22, 1982 where he began a lifelong career serving the City of Hialeah for 39 years; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, he became one of the original HAZMAT team members in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, in October 27, 1991, he was promoted to Driver/Engineer

WHEREAS, his latest promotion was to Chief Engineer; and






