

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-027

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR, AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF, A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (e-RATE) FOR SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES, FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022, FOR DISCOUNTS ON INTERNET SERVICES WHEREBY THE GRANT PROVIDES FOR AN 80% DISCOUNT TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH'S PUBLIC LIBRARIES FOR INTERNET SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$12,840.00 FOR INTERNET SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in its best interest to continue a program for discounted internet services for the Hialeah Public Libraries, including the JFK Memorial Library and the Curtiss, North, Walker, West and Wilde branches, funded in part by the Federal Universal Service Fund for Schools and Libraries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah, through its Library Department, has successfully participated in this program for 24 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the application for, and the acceptance of, a grant from the Federal Universal Service Fund (e-rate) for schools and libraries, for State Fiscal Year 2021-2022, for discounts on internet services whereby the grant provides for an 80% discount to the City of Hialeah's Public Libraries for internet services.

Section 3: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the expenditure of \$12,840.00 for internet services.

Section 4: Effective Date.


This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




