RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF WEST 25th STREET FROM WEST 4th COURT TO WEST 8th AVENUE HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "MICHAEL WRIGHT WAY", IN HONOR OF THE OUTSTANDING SERVICE OF MICHAEL WRIGHT, THE FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN FIREFIGHTER IN THE CITY OF HIALEAH, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this Resolution on March 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the designation of West 25th Street from West 4th Court to West 8th Avenue Hialeah, Florida, as "Michael Wright Way", is in honor of the outstanding service of Michael Wright, the first African American firefighter in the City of Hialeah, and who after twenty-five years of outstanding service retired as a Lieutenant; and



the City of Hialeah, his achievements, leadership, and perseverance, with the cost of signage to be paid by the City.




