

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-056

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO TRANSFER, APPROXIMATELY \$989,165.75 OF THE \$4,202,188.00 CARES ACT FUNDS PASS THROUGH FROM MIAMI DADE COUNTY FROM ALL REMAINING FUND TO CREATE A SECOND BUSINESS RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic has caused disruption in Florida's economy leading to high rates of unemployment and business closures; and

WHEREAS, many businesses of the City of Hialeah are in need of assistance with rental payments; and

WHEREAS, the City, via Resolution No. 2020-169 (November 24, 2020), previously allocated CARES Act funds for local businesses in the City of Hialeah for rental assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the community to transfer, approximately \$989,165.75 of the \$4,202,188.00 of the CARES Act funds pass through from Miami-Dade County from all remaining programs, to create a second business rental assistance program to assist the local businesses of the City who have suffered loss of business income and financial hardship due to this unprecedented health crisis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The Mayor or designee, the Director of the Grants and Human Services Annette Quintana, is hereby directed to transfer, approximately \$989,165.75 of the \$4,202,188.00 of the CARES Act funds pass through from Miami-Dade County from all remaining programs, for a second business rental assistance program to assist the local businesses of the City who have suffered loss of business income and have incurred financial hardship.

Section 3: The Mayor or designee, the Director of the Grants and Human Services Annette Quintana, and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, are hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute all necessary documents in furtherance hereof. All actions to date and any future

actions regarding expenditure of these funds by the established deadline by officers of the City in furtherance and performance of these programs are hereby approved, confirmed, and ratified.






