RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) THROUGH THE PASSING OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE ACT ARP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,388,586 OF HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP (HOME-ARP) FUNDS, APPROVING THE USE OF HOME-ARP FUNDS FOR ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO REGULATORY WAIVERS ISSUED BY HUD IN RESPONSE TO ECONOMIC INJURY, AS A RESULT OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) AND TO SUBMIT A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S 2020 PROGRAM YEAR ACTION PLAN; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, DIRECTOR OF GRANTS AND HUMAN SERVICES ANNETTE QUINTANA, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO EXECUTE ALL OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States of America declared a national emergency on March 13, 2020, in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Act of 2021 (ARP) was signed into law by the President of the United States of America on March 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the ARP Act provides an allocation of HOME Investment Partnership (HOME-ARP) Program funds awarded to the City of Hialeah, through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) in the amount of \$5,388,586; and

WHEREAS, this resolution approves the use of HOME-ARP funds in an amount not to exceed \$5,388,586, to address housing and rental needs through eligible HOME activities that include, but are not limited to, creating new affordable housing, providing tenant-based rental assistance or supportive services; and

WHEREAS, this resolution approves the submission of a substantial amendment to the City's 2020 program year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and wellbeing of its residents to utilize HOME-ARP funding to address our communities housing needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as it fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby accepts a grant award from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the HOME Investment Partnership (HOME-ARP) Program in the amount of \$5,388,586 to address housing and rental needs through eligible HOME activities that include, but are not limited to, creating new affordable housing, providing tenant-based rental assistance or supportive services.

Section 3: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor and his designees to prepare and submit a substantial amendment to the City's 2019 program year annual Action Plan.

Section 4: The Mayor or his designee, the Director of Grants and Human Services Annette Quintana, on behalf of the City are authorized, to execute all necessary documents in furtherance thereof. All action to date by officers of the City in furtherance and performance of this program is hereby approved, confirmed, and ratified.

Section 5: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




