

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-055

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO A POLE ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH T-MOBILE SOUTH LLC, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED TO THIS RESOLUTION, FOR FIVE YEARS, COMMENCING ON THE DATE SIGNED BY THE MAYOR, WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR FOUR SUCCESSIVE FIVE YEAR TERMS, FOR T-MOBILE'S USE OF THE CITY'S LIGHT POLES LOCATED IN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR PLACEMENT OF WIRELESS ANTENNAS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to enter into a Pole Attachment Agreement with the T-Mobile to provide wireless antennas and associated equipment on the City's light poles located in the public rights-of-way within the municipal boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the government of the City of Hialeah to ensure that adequate levels of wireless services are quick and efficient within the City; and

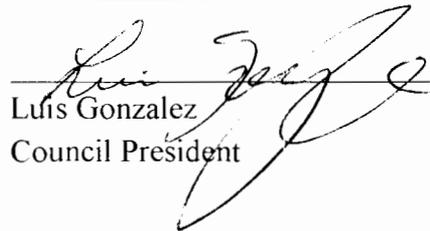
WHEREAS, T-Mobile in providing such services has agreed to indemnify the City for its use of the City's poles to ensure the public safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City, to enter into the Pole Attachment Agreement with the T-Mobile South LLC to provide wireless services in the City for five years, with an option to renew for four consecutive five year terms, commencing on the date signed by the Mayor.

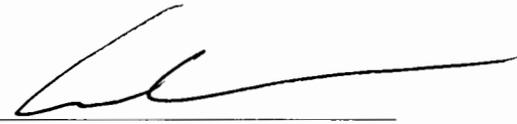

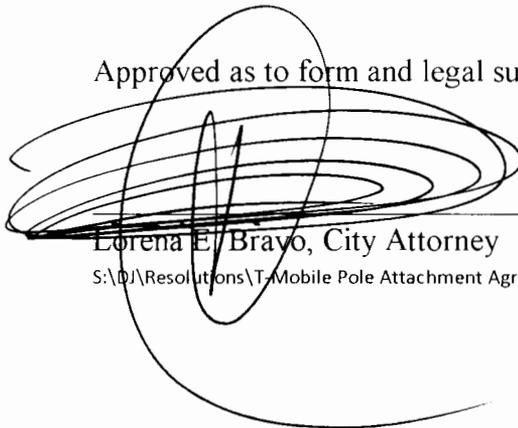
