

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-057

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A "PIGGY BACK CONTRACT" PURSUANT TO HIALEAH CODE OF ORDINANCES §2-818 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OFFICE DEPOT, INC., FOR OFFICE SUPPLIES; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS; pursuant to Hialeah Code of Ordinances § 2-818 the City is authorized to piggyback and enter into contracts without competitive bidding by utilizing existing local, state or other governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of a contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac issued a Request for Proposal # 13-23R for office supplies and this process is substantially similar to the RFP process used by the City in its procurement of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, Office Depot, Inc., was awarded the contract for the period of October 18, 2013 through October 17, 2016, with a one three year renewal option that was renewed on September 28, 2016 for the period of time from October 18, 2016 through October 17, 2019 ("Tamarac contract").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Council hereby approve and authorize the City to enter into a contract with office Depot Inc., through October 17, 2019, based on the competitively procured Tamarac contract.

Section 3: Authorization of City Officials.

The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City, to take all steps necessary to implement the terms and conditions of this resolution and to execute a contract with Office Depot, Inc. on substantial material terms, including scope and prices, as the Tamarac contract.

Section 4: Effective Date.

This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.

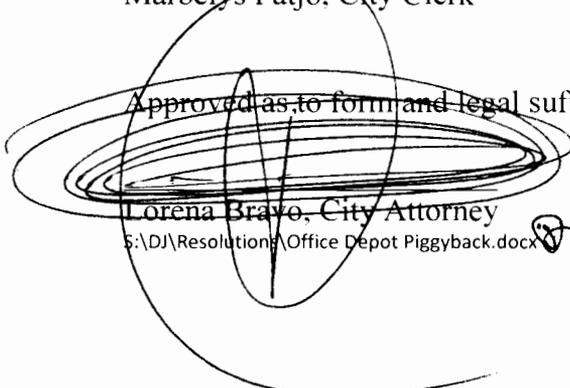
