

RESOLUTION NO.: 2017-059

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY NINE DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$15,999.60) FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND - *STATE*, TO PURCHASE LAW ENFORCEMENT AMMUNITION FROM FLORIDA BULLET, INC., A *SOLE SOURCE* VENDOR, AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AS IT IS ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE CITY, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department faces potential violent situations; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department needs to train and equip its officers with law enforcement quality ammunition so they can reliably and effectively respond to the many scenes in which subjects are armed with various types of weapons, including firearms; and

WHEREAS, the *sole source* to obtain specific brands of law enforcement ammunition that the Hialeah Police Department is seeking to purchase is Florida Bullet, Inc.; and the Hialeah Police Department seeks to waive competitive bidding as it is advantageous to the City, and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *State*; and


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with all applicable statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$15,999.60 from the Law Enforcement


Trust Fund – *State*, for the purchase of law enforcement ammunition from Florida Bullet, Inc, a *sole source* vendor, and waiving competitive bidding as it is advantageous to the City, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.


