
RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, TO ACCEPT STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$629,541 AND ADMINISTERED BY THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY TO BE USED IN THE REHABILITATION OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES OWNED BY QUALIFYING LOW-INCOME FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF HIALEAH DURING THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2017 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah has been awarded the amount of \$629,541 by the State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program, administered by the Florida Housing Finance Agency, for the purpose of rehabilitating as many residential properties owned by qualifying low-income families within the City, from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor on behalf of the City of Hialeah, to accept State Housing Initiative Partnership Program Funds appropriated by the Florida legislature in the amount of \$629,541 and administered by the Florida Housing Finance Agency to be used in the rehabilitation of residential properties owned by qualifying low-income families throughout the City of Hialeah during the term of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020, and further authorizes the Mayor on behalf of the City to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution.


