RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM'S RENTAL ASSISTANCE /RAPID RE-HOUSING SUB-RECIPIENT SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITRUS HEALTH NETWORK, INC. AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA EXECUTED BY THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1", TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT TO HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES IN NEED OF PERMANENT HOUSING, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$410,730.90, FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON MAY 4, 2017 AND ENDING ON JUNE 15, 2018; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah is the recipient of State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds from the State of Florida through the Florida Housing Finance Corporation;

WHEREAS, Rapid Re-Housing is a housing intervention program that assists families and individuals experiencing homelessness to find permanent housing with short-to medium-term rental and utility assistance and supportive services;

WHEREAS, Rapid Re-housing is an eligible activity under SHIP regulations and the City desires to use SHIP funding for Rapid Re-Housing to serve homeless individuals and families meeting the State of Florida requirements;

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) executed on March 16, 2017, by and between the City of Hialeah and Miami-Dade County Homeless Trust, Citrus Health Network, Inc. has been selected as the agency to administer and implement the City of Hialeah's SHIP, Rental Assistance Rapid Re-Housing Program;

WHEREAS, Citrus Health Network, Inc. is a non-profit organization who was assigned to the City, and represents it is that qualified to perform the various described SHIP Rapid Re-Housing administrative and implementation activities needed for a successful program; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into this Sub-recipient Services Agreement with Citrus Health Network, Inc. to provide financial assistance and support to homeless individuals and families in need of permanent housing, in the total amount of \$410,730.90, for a term commencing on May 4, 2017 and ending on June 15, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as it fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves and ratifies a State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program's Rental Assistance /Rapid Re-Housing Sub-Recipient Services Agreement between Citrus Health Network, Inc. and the City of Hialeah, Florida executed by the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Hialeah, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1", to provide financial assistance and support to homeless individuals and families in need of permanent housing, in the total amount of \$410,730.90, for a term commencing on May 4, 2017 and ending on June 15, 2018, and further authorizes the Mayor on behalf of the City to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution. All action taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance of the performance of this agreement is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.
