

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-071

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CHILDREN'S TRUST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$905,998.00 FOR AFTERCARE AND SUMMER CAMP PROGRAMS FOR ONE-YEAR COMMENCING ON AUGUST 1, 2017 THROUGH JULY 31, 2018; RATIFYING THE GRANT AGREEMENT, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HEREAFTER AND INCORPORATED HEREIN AS EXHIBIT "A"; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS, AND DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in 2002, Miami-Dade County voters approved a dedicated revenue source to fund programs for children through the mechanism of The Children's Trust; and

WHEREAS, The Children's Trust encourages creative approaches, through public-private partnerships, to improve services and access to children and families; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah has been awarded a grant to provides after-school/camp programs through The Children's Trust and desires to enter into a one-year grant agreement in furtherance thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community to accept the grant award to benefit its children and residents and enter into a new grant agreement accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts a grant award from the Miami-Dade County Children's Trust in the amount of \$905,998.00 for afterschool and summer camp programs for one-year commencing on August 1, 2017 and ending on July 31, 2018.




