RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,500.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *FEDERAL*, TO COVER AN INSTALLMENT PAYMENT DUE UNDER A PURCHASE ORDER EXECUTED WITH COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS & LOGISTICS, INC., FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THE EXISTING HIALEAH POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER SYSTEM AND THE ACQUISITION, INSTALLATION, AND CONFIGURATION OF A NEW AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER SYSTEM, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2017, the City Council authorized the issuance of a purchase order with Communication Systems & Logistics, Inc. for the removal and disposal of the existing automated license plate reader system and to purchase, install, and configure a new automated license plate reader system (“ALPR”); and

WHEREAS, ALPR technology provides real-time analytical data that is valuable and effective in reducing, preventing and detecting crime; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department seeks to make the September 2017 payment pursuant to the purchase order; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the *Guide to Equitable Sharing*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$60,500.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *Federal*, to to cover an installment payment due under the

purchase order executed with Communication Systems & Logistics, Inc. for the removal and disposal of the existing automated license plate reader system and to purchase, install, and configure a new automated license plate reader system ("ALPR"), upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.




