

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-106**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SPECIFIC APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO HIALEAH, FLA. CHARTER SECTION 3.08(d) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$162,800.00 FROM THE UNASSIGNED GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND ACCOUNTS TO PURCHASE FIRE ALARM REPLACEMENT AND REPAIRS AT 57 UNITS, 32 UNITS, AND 18 UNITS DESCRIBED IN THE BID PROPOSAL DATED JULY 7, 2021 FROM G&R ELECTRIC, CORPORATION ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT A; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Hialeah Charter 3.08(d) allows the City Council, upon request of the Mayor and within the last 6 months of the fiscal year, to any unencumbered appropriation balance or portion thereof from one office or department to another, by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


**Section 1:** The City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby approves a specific appropriation pursuant to Hialeah, Fla. Charter Section 3.08(d) in the amount of \$162,800.00 from the Unassigned General Fund balance to the Affordable Housing Fund accounts to purchase fire alarm replacement and repairs at 57 units, 32 units, and 18 units described in the bid proposal dated July 7, 2021 from G&R Electric Corporation, attached as Exhibit "A".

**Section 2:** This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida and signed by the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.
