

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-25

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI AS A PARTICIPATING MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE FOR REQUESTING AND RENDERING ASSISTANCE FOR ROUTINE AND INTENSIVE LAW ENFORCEMENT SITUATIONS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AGREEMENT THROUGH JANUARY 1, 2020, AND ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"..

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah and the City of South Miami are so located in relation to each other that it is to the advantage of each to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of law enforcement services and resources to adequately respond to law enforcement situations; and


WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Florida Statutes, the "Florida Mutual Aid Act," permits law enforcement agencies to enter into a combined mutual aid agreement which permits voluntary cooperation and assistance of a routine or emergency law enforcement nature; and

WHEREAS, a Mutual Aid Agreement of this nature would be beneficial to the City of Hialeah.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:






