

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-41

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR ACCESS TO THE AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM, IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMITY WITH THE AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to enter into an interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade County, pursuant to section 163.01, Florida Statutes, that allows local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers to enable them to cooperate with other localities on the basis of mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah and Miami-Dade County both desire to provide their citizens with the best possible use of the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS); and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade Police Department, supported by the Forensic Services Bureau, operates an AFIS which allows the Hialeah Police Department to electronically send fingerprints and palm prints to the AFIS for purposes of criminal and/or civil identification; and


WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department desires access to the AFIS as an integral component of identifying print evidence recovered from crime scenes, for the identification of subjects, and for other law enforcement related activities requiring the use of the Miami-Dade Police Department AFIS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City, to enter into an interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade County for access to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS), in substantial conformity with the agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1", providing for an effective date.




