

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-151

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,518.80 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND-*STATE* FOR THE PURCHASE OF SPEER BRAND LAW ENFORCEMENT AMMUNITION AND FEDERAL CARTRIDGE PRODUCTS, AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AS FLORIDA BULLET, INC. IS THE SOLE SOURCE DISTRIBUTOR FOR SAID PRODUCTS IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the practice of the Hialeah Police Department to train all its sworn officers to respond quickly and effectively to any situation, including hostage barricades and active shooter situations, in the most professional manner possible to protect life and property; and

WHEREAS, Special Weapons and Tactics Team (S.W.A.T.) in the Hialeah Police Department is a law enforcement unit which needs to be fully equipped with necessary tools in order to respond and take whatever action may be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department recently completed a yearly rifle qualification and is in need of Speer brand ammunition and Federal cartridge products to replenish the Department's inventory; and

WHEREAS, Speer brand ammunition is built to meet the demanding needs of a law enforcement agency; and

WHEREAS, Florida Bullet, Inc. is an active corporation in good standing in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Florida Bullet Inc. is the factory authorized law enforcement distributor in the State of Florida for Speer brand and Federal cartridge products, see "Exhibit 1" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, Florida Bullet, Inc. has provided a quote of \$98,518.80 for ammunition and cartridge needed, see "Exhibit 2" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from account #105.1000.521.640 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

WHEREAS, Section 932.7055, Fla. Stat. (2018), the Florida Contraband and Forfeiture Act, authorizes the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds for this purpose and the funds are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* account for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City of Hialeah Police Department has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable rules, regulations and guidelines governing the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

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WHEREAS, the City finds the expenditure is in the public interest;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the expenditure of an amount not exceeding \$98,518.80 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* for the purchase of ammunition and cartridge from Florida Bullet, Inc., a corporation pursuant to a competitive bid having specifications and pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in "Exhibit 1."

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




