

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$932,425.00 AND ADMINISTERED BY THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY TO BE USED IN THE REHABILITATION OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES OWNED BY QUALIFYING LOW INCOME FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF HIALEAH DURING THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2016 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS RESOLUTION.


WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah has been awarded and allocation in the amount of \$932,425.00 from the State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program, under the Florida Housing Finance Agency, for the purpose of rehabilitating as many residential properties owned by low-income families within the City, from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to accept State Housing Initiative Partnership Program Funds appropriated by the Florida legislature in the amount of \$932,425.00 and administered by the Florida Housing Finance agency to be used in the rehabilitation of residential properties owned by qualifying low income families throughout the City of Hialeah during the term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.

Section 2: The Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.




