

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-78

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A DIRECT AWARD FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$60,987.00, FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF POLICE PATROL VEHICLES; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHEREANCE THEREOF; AND AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEPARATE INTEREST BEARING TRUST ACCOUNT DESIGNATED FOR THIS PROGRAM.


WHEREAS, the City is eligible to receive a direct award in the amount of \$60,987.00 under the US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance's Fiscal Year 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, for the procurement of police patrol vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA; THAT:


Section 1: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the Mayor or his designee to accept a direct award from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, under the Fiscal Year 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, for the total amount of \$60,987.00, for the procurement of police patrol vehicles, and authorize the Mayor or his designee to execute all necessary documents in furtherance thereof.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida further authorize the establishment of a separate interest-bearing trust account designated for this program.




