

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA HOUSING COALITION, A FLORIDA CORPORATION, TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO OUR SHIP PROGRAM, FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON AUGUST 1, 2016 AND ENDING ON FEBRUARY 28, 2017; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO EXECUTE THE SERVICES AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO IN SUBSTANTIAL FORM, AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1".

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah is required to update and maintain full compliance with the SHIP program requirements;


WHEREAS, Florida Housing Coalition has experience with the SHIP program and has performed technical assistance for the City of Hialeah for its state and federally funded programs in a professional, efficient and competent manner. The City has worked with the Florida Housing Coalition for over 23 years; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a contract with Florida Housing Coalition to conduct an assessment for the SHIP Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves a services agreement with Florida Housing Coalition, a Florida corporation, to provide technical assistance to our SHIP Program, for a term commencing on August 1, 2016 and ending on February 28, 2017, and authorizes the Mayor or his designee and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City, to execute the services agreement attached hereto in substantial form, and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1".




