

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-021**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF GAP INSURANCE THROUGH AMERICAN PUBLIC LIFE TO SUPPLEMENT THE CITY'S OPEN ACCESS PLUS EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,750,000.00; AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PPO PLAN THROUGH UNITED HEALTH CARE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,600,000.00 FOR THE 2022 CALENDAR YEAR; FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,350,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, these additional insurance benefits complement the City's employee health insurance program, provide better coverage for eligible employees and help employees defray the cost of health care; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds these expenditures serve the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


**Section 1:** The total expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$4,350,000.00 is hereby approved as follows: (i) \$1,750,000.00 to acquire gap insurance through American Public Life to supplement the City's open access plus employee health insurance plan; and (ii) \$2,600,000.00 to purchase Medicare Advantage PPO insurance plan through United Health Care for Medicare eligible retirees and their spouses; both plans covering the calendar year 2022, beginning January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. All actions taken to date by officers and employees of the City in connection with the procurement of these policies of insurance are hereby approved, confirmed, and ratified.

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**Section 2:** This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


