

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-035

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,121 FROM SEVERAL PARTICIPATING SPONSORS AT THE "BATTLE OF THE BADGES – POLICE V. FIRE" EVENT AND APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SAME AMOUNT, SPLIT IN HALF AND DEPOSITED INTO TWO REVENUE ACCOUNTS NOS. 109.0000.369220 (FIRE RESCUE FUND-FUNDRAISER REVENUE-BATTLE OF THE BADGES) AND 121.1000.369220 (POLICE GRANT FUND-FUNDRAISER REVENUE-BATTLE OF THE BADGES) TO PAY FOR UNIFORMS, SUPPLIES, PUBLICATIONS, MEMBERSHIPS AND OTHER ITEMS TO FUND A FIRE EXPLORER AND POLICE CADET YOUTH PROGRAMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The donation of \$23,121 from the sponsors and in the amounts identified in the attached "Exhibit 1" is hereby accepted.

Section 2: A supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$23,121.00, split in half and deposited into two revenue accounts nos. 109.0000.369220 (Fire Rescue Fund-Fundraiser Revenue-Battle of the Badges) and 121.1000.369220 (Police Grant Fund-Fundraiser Revenue-Battle of the Badges) to fund a fire explorer and police cadet youth programs is hereby approved. The monies will be utilized to pay for uniforms, supplies, publications, memberships and miscellaneous other items in connection with the operating expenses of the programs.

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida and signed by the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.



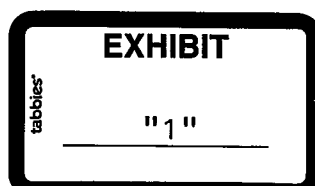
