

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$63,021.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – STATE ACCOUNT AND THE CAPITAL OUTLAY BYRNE (JAG) DOJ GRANT, TO PURCHASE THREE 2017 CHEVROLET CITY EXPRESS CARGO VANS FROM ROUNTREE MOORE CHEVROLET CADILLAC., UTILIZING THE PRICING ESTABLISHED BY A COMPETITIVE BID FROM THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, BID #16-VEL24.0, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department desires to purchase three (3) Chevrolet City Express Cargo Vans at \$21,007.00 per unit, totaling an amount not to exceed \$63,021.00, from Rountree Moore Chevrolet Cadillac utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association, BID #16-VEL24.0, to replace the aging fleet of Crime Scene Investigation Unit vehicles that are no longer cost-effective to maintain and cannot properly store and utilize the Hialeah Police Department's necessary investigative equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace police vehicles in order to take vehicles out of service that are no longer dependable and have reached the end of their service life and avoid significant repair and maintenance expenses; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles will assist criminal activity investigations and store a wide range of crime scene investigative tools and equipment; and


WHEREAS, the funds needed to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State*; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$63,021.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State* and the Capital Outlay Byrne (Jag) DOJ Grant for the purchase of three Chevrolet City Express Cargo Vans from Rountree Moore Chevrolet Cadillac., utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from Florida Sheriff’s Association, BID #16-VEL24.0, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.


