

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-070

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AMENDING HIALEAH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2020-144 (OCTOBER 27, 2020) WHICH ESTABLISHED A TEN MEMBER LOCAL AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF HIALEAH, TO CHANGE APPOINTEES AND REDUCE THE NUMBER OF APPOINTEES FROM TEN TO EIGHT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah Fla. Resolution 2020-144 (Oct. 27, 2020), the City of Hialeah established a ten-member Local Affordable Housing Advisory Committee to recommend to the City Council specific local housing initiatives and incentive strategies designed to encourage and facilitate affordable housing for the State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program (“SHIP Program”), appointed committee members, provided for their term of services and provided for the definition of “Affordable Housing”; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah wishes to update its Affordable Housing Advisory Committee to reflect current representatives who meet the criteria set forth in Florida Statute §420.9076(2) as revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah hereby amends Hialeah Fla. Resolution 2020-144 (Oct. 27, 2020) to change appointees and hereby appoints the following eight (8) individuals as members of the Local Affordable Housing Advisory Committee:




