

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-20

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE HEALTH FOUNDATION OF SOUTH FLORIDA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,000.00 FOR A COMPLETE STREETS PLAN AND PROJECT FOR TWELVE MONTHS, COMMENCING ON APRIL 1, 2015 AND ENDING ON MARCH 31, 2016, RATIFYING THE GRANT AGREEMENT, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS AND SUBCONTRACTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in September 2014, the City of Hialeah applied for a grant with the Health Foundation of South Florida for a complete streets plans and project; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2014, the Health Foundation of South Florida awarded the grant to the City of Hialeah in an amount of \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant award is part of a two-year grant cycle in which the Health Foundation of South Florida will fund the first two years entirely with the City of Hialeah receiving \$80,000.00 per grant cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community to enter into a grant agreement with the Health Foundation of South Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts a grant award from the Health Foundation of South Florida in the annual amount of \$80,000 for a complete streets plan and project, for one year, commencing on April 1, 2015 and ending on March 31, 2016, ratifies the

Grant Agreement, and further authorizes the Mayor and designee to execute any and all documents and subcontracts in furtherance thereof.

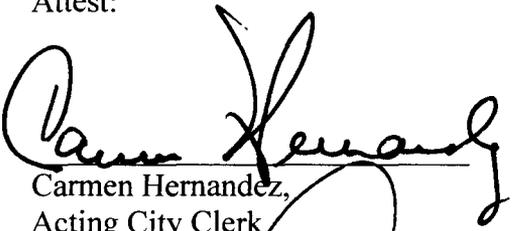

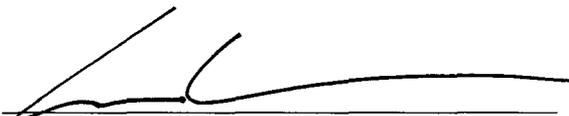

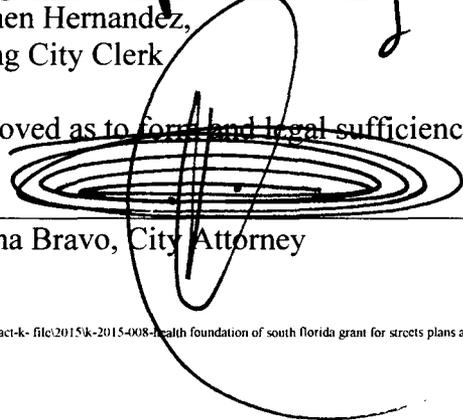
