RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DOLLARWISE INNOVATION GRANT 2015 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF MAYORS, TO SUPPORT THE CITY'S FINANCIAL LITERACY EDUCATION PROGRAMS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO SUBMIT ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF THE DOLLARWISE INNOVATION GRANT 2015.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah is continuously searching for available grants as a source of funding to support the City's financial literacy education programs; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it is in the best interest of the welfare of the community to support the development and the expansion of City's financial literacy education programs by accepting this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT

Section 1: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from the United States Conference of Mayors, to support the City's financial literacy education programs offered at the City's public library system for the purpose of promoting healthy financial habits and educating the community on topics such as management of personal finances, investment opportunities, and retirement planning; and authorizing the Mayor and the

City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City to submit any and all documentation required for the disbursement of the DollarWise Innovation Grant 2015.




